STANDARDS OF CONDUCT
YOUTH SERVICES

The Youth Services department is intended to be a space for parents/caregivers and children to use for informational and recreational purposes. In order to maintain an environment in which parents/caregivers and children feel welcome and safe, we ask that adults without children under the age of 18 use the Adult Services department. Table and seating space is limited in the Youth Services department, so adults without children will be directed to use a table or chair/couch in the Adult Services department.

For the comfort and safety of our Youth Services patrons, the following are not allowed in the Youth Services Department:

- conducting meetings or interviews
- leaving unattended children
- displaying intoxication
- eating or drinking (drinks allowed in closed containers)
- extreme body odor
- misusing and/or damaging library property
- loitering or waiting for a bus
- harassing, touching, or threatening patrons and/or staff
- excessively loud cell phone conversations
- speaker phone conversations prohibited
- music – must use headphones
- running
- sleeping
- smoking or use of tobacco products including e-cigarettes
- soliciting: petitions, surveys, donations, etc.
- talking loudly or making excessive noise
- cursing, swearing and/or abusive language
- using cameras
- abusing computer privileges
- animals, other than service animals

Shirts and shoes are required.

Violations may result in the suspension or limitation of library privileges
